NFV Testing Provides Critical Step in Virtualizing Networks

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Report Highlights

The promises of greater flexibility and dramatically reduced time to service, coupled with cost advantages, are driving communications service providers to deploy NFV-based services.

While opex and capex savings from NFV are considered a given, the primary driver for NFV is the ability it provides operators to rapidly deploy revenue-generating services.

Virtual network functions provide an opportunity to deliver new services that enable incremental revenue for service providers on top of the traditional connectivity services that they provide.

NFV provides operators the flexibility to deploy a wide range of network functions purchased from different vendors on the same server in a timescale measured in days, as opposed to years.

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
